I. Christ's Suffering – We are Called – Vs. 21

“For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us”

II. Christ's Steps – We must Follow – Vs. 21

“because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow in his steps:”

III. Christ's Sinlessness – We must Separate – Vs. 22

Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth;”

IV. Christ's Selflessness – We must Humble – Vs. 23

“Who when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:”

“reviled” in 1 Peter 2:23 – translated from the Greek word, “λοιδορουμενος” – denotes to abuse, revile

V. Christ's Sacrifice – We must Live – Vs. 24

“Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness:”

VI. Christ's Strickening – We must Remember – Vs. 24

“by whose stipes ye were healed.”

“healed” in 1 Peter 2:24 – translated from the Greek word, “ιαθητε” – to heal

VII. Christ's Shepherhood – We must Rejoice – Vs. 25

“For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.”

“Shepherd” in 1 Peter 2:25 – translated from the Greek word, “ποιμενα” – Metaphorically, Shepherd – Pastor
